Millions of Americans, irrespective of political party, in hundreds of cities and towns and numerous States have called for a 28<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the U.S. Constitution that will reverse *Citizens United* and restore equal representation, accountable government, fair and free elections, and the unalienable rights of human beings, not corporations, in our Constitution.

(1)	Demand that the United States Congress pass and send to the States for ratification a Constitutional amendment that effectively overturns Citizens United, restoring the ability of our communities, states and nation to limit the corroding effect of concentrated money in our elections, and protecting the rights of human beings, not corporations, in our Constitution; and
(2)	<i>Instruct</i> our elected representatives at every level of government to assist with the prompt enactment of the 28 <sup>th</sup> Amendment reflecting the above principles and to enact campaign finance, anti-corruption and other laws and policies consistent with these principles.
