AUTHORITY**

18 Arizona Secretary of State Katie Hobbs (“Secretary”) respectfully submits this  
19 notice of the decision issued on October 2, 2020, by the Eleventh Circuit Court of  
20 Appeals in *The New Georgia Project, et al. v. Raffensperger, et al.*, No. 20-13360-D  
21 (11th Cir. Oct. 2, 2020) (attached), which supports the arguments in the Secretary’s  
22 response opposing Plaintiffs’ emergency motion for temporary restraining order and  
23 preliminary injunction.

24 In *Raffensperger*, a majority of the Eleventh Circuit panel held that the district  
25 court “misapplied the *Anderson-Burdick* framework when it enjoined the State  
26 defendants’ enforcement of a long-standing Georgia absentee ballot deadline,” and  
27 instead “manufactured its own ballot deadline[.]” No. 20-13360-D at 2. The majority  
28 reasoned that Georgia’s “decades-old absentee ballot deadline is both reasonable and
