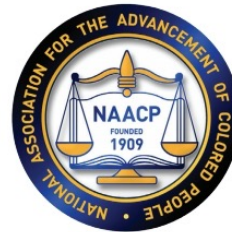

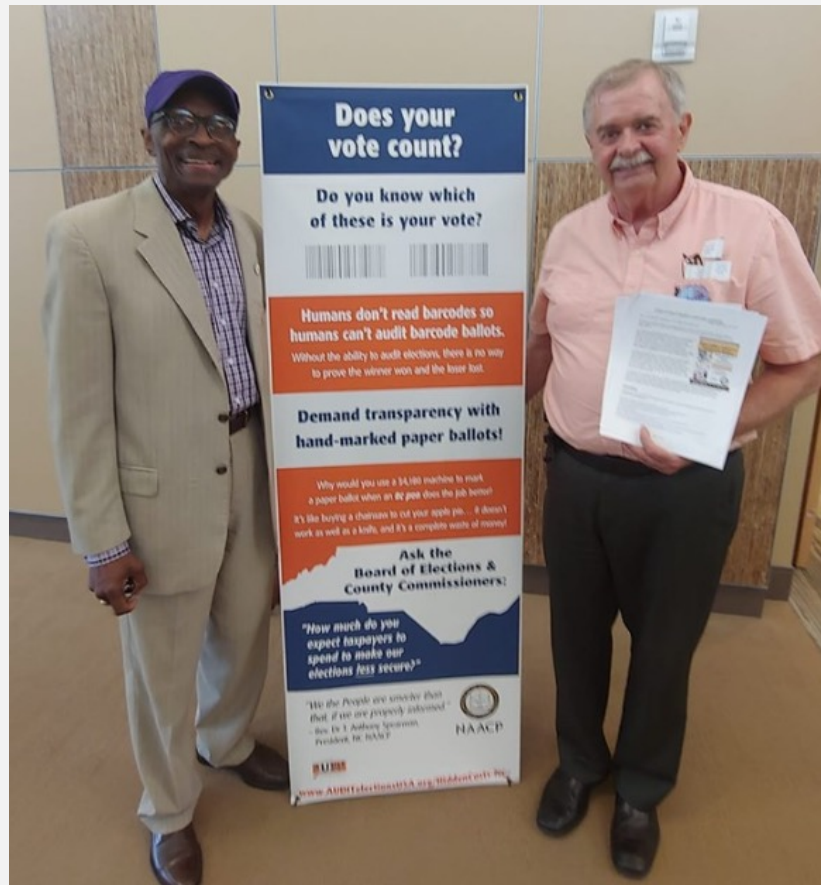

DR. SPEARMAN'S TESTIMONY TO THE US HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES COMMITTEE ON HOUSE ADMINISTRATION JANUARY 9, 2020



“After two postponements to vote on a system, Guilford County Board of Elections decided to proceed with Hand Marked Paper Ballots....

The Guilford County Board of Commissioners had budgeted **\$8,000,000** for the voting system and our total cost came to **\$2,200,000** amounting to a savings of **\$5,800,000** which the commissioners **partially reallocated to increase the pay of school bus drivers and other employees.** We would hope others would follow the Guilford County model. We remain reasonably assured that it will help to restore trust and confidence in the election process.”
