ORDER

On September 20, 2023, we notified the parties that this appeal is scheduled for oral argument on November 2, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. The schedule for oral argument is set forth below, which modifies the prior order of September 20, 2023, regarding the location for oral argument.

Based upon all the files, records, and proceedings herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the schedule for oral argument shall proceed as follows:

- 1. Ronald Fein, counsel on behalf of petitioners, shall proceed first and will receive 35 minutes of time. Petitioners may reserve a portion of the allotted time for rebuttal.
- 2. Nathan J. Hartshorn, counsel on behalf of Steven Simon, Minnesota Secretary of State, shall proceed next and will receive 10 minutes of time.

3. Rondell Reid LeBeau, II, counsel on behalf of the Republican Party of

Minnesota, and Nicholas J. Nelson, counsel on behalf of Donald J. Trump and Donald J.

Trump for President 2024, Inc., have each filed notices indicating they intend to present

oral argument. Together they will receive 25 minutes of time and will proceed next.

Pursuant to Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 134.03, subd. 1, when multiple parties wish to argue

"they shall mutually agree to divide the allotted time among themselves." Counsel must

notify the court in writing of how they intend to split their allotted time on or before

Monday, October 30, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that oral argument on November 2, 2023, at 10:00

a.m. will be held in Courtroom 300, at the Minnesota Judicial Center, Saint Paul,

Minnesota.
