**ENTRY OF DEFAULT AS TO
STEVE KRAMER**

For the reasons stated in the Plaintiffs' Unassented-to Motion for Entry of Default Against Steve Kramer Pursuant to Rule 55(a), (Doc. No. 90), the undersigned finds that defendant Steve Kramer was properly served with the original complaint pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(e)(2)(B), and that he was properly served with the first amended complaint pursuant to RSA 510:4, II and Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(e)(1) (permitting service by following the law of the state where the district court is located).

Defendant Kramer having failed to respond within the time and in the manner provided by Fed. R. Civ. P. 12, the plaintiffs' motion for default (Doc. No. 90) is granted. Default is herewith entered as to Defendant Kramer in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 55(a) and Local Rule 55.1.

A damages hearing will be scheduled upon adjudication of all the remaining claims or parties.

Local Rule 55.1(a) requires that the serving party give notice of the entry of default to the defaulting party by

regular mail sent to the last known address of the defaulted party and certify to the court that notice has been sent.
