About the Free America Walkout

Women’s March has launched the [Free America Walkout](#), calling on people across the country to walk out of work, school, and commerce on January 20 to send a message that we are walking away from fascism. One year into Trump’s second regime, we face an escalating fascist threat: raids on our communities, troops occupying our cities, attacks on immigrants, families torn apart, mass surveillance, and terror used to keep us silent.

About Walk In for Impeachment

In solidarity with this day of action, [50501 Movement](#), [Citizens’ Impeachment](#), [Free Speech For People](#), the [Removal Coalition](#), and [Women’s March](#), announced a collaboration to encourage people participating in the Free America Walkout to *walk in* to lobby their congressional offices in their districts, demanding that Members of Congress advance articles of impeachment against Trump and senior Trump officials for multiple abuses of power.

In the time since his second inauguration, Trump has carried out an assault on the rule of law, on the checks and balances of power between our coequal branches of government, and on the United States Constitution. He is committing multiple abuses of power in violation of clear constitutional commands and at the expense of our democratic institutions, constitutional precedent, and the health and safety of all of our people, especially the most marginalized. It is the constitutional responsibility of Congress to take action by impeaching and removing Trump from office.

How to Participate:

On Tuesday, January 20, walk out of school or work and go to your House Representative’s district congressional office and tell them to impeach and remove Trump from office now. Use the talking points below as a resource for your visit. You can do this on your own or create or join an event. Talking Points

- In the time since his second inauguration, Trump has carried out an assault on the rule of law, on the checks and balances of power between our coequal branches of government, and on the United States Constitution. He is committing multiple abuses of power in violation of clear constitutional commands and at the expense of our democratic institutions, constitutional precedent, and the health and safety of all of our people, especially the most vulnerable.
- Congress must take action and impeach and remove him immediately. In our Constitution, there is one remedy for high crimes committed by a US President, and that is impeachment. Congress must impeach and remove a president who tramples on the rule of law and the Constitution.
- No one is above the law, not even the president. As elected representatives, members of Congress need to uphold their oath to protect and defend the Constitution. Doing nothing would embolden Trump to continue breaking the law — and set a dangerous precedent for future presidents.
- **I call on you as my elected representative to uphold the Constitution and impeach and remove Trump for his high crimes. Introduce articles of impeachment and force a floor vote immediately.**
