

How to Guide: Impeachment Read-A-Long

This resource is intended to lay out a step by step guide on how you can create your own DIY (do it yourself) community read-a-thon to better inform the general public of Trump's long list of impeachable offenses. His grave abuses of power make it the duty of Congress to immediately impeach, convict, and remove him from the office of the US presidency.

You can easily manage a DIY (do it yourself) impeachment read-a-long by using a shared tracking sheet such as Proton or Google Sheets. This will make it easier to assign/highlight sections for each speaker and to make sure you are reading from the [same document](#). Here is a 3-step guide on how to divide, read, and record a long document (70+ pages) among a 7-10 person team.

***Note:** You can have as few or as many readers as needed but you should be aware of how long it will take each individual to read their section of the document.*

1. Division of Readers:

- Divide page count by 7-10 (*depending on how many readers you have - assign sections accordingly.*)
- Find Natural Breaks: adjust assigned sections to end at natural breaks (*ex. end of each impeachable offense*).
- Assign Tracks: Label the sections as *Reader 1* through *Reader 7* and assign specific pages to each person.

2. Track Assigned Sections: Create a shared spreadsheet with the following columns:

- Reader Name: The assigned team member.
- Assigned Section: Pages/offenses covered.
- Status: Dropdown menu for *Not Started*, *In Progress*, or *Completed* (optional).
- Date Due: Deadline for each person to finish recording and send content.

3. Recording and Editing Process: Assign one person to collect all video content and share it with jfoley@freespeechforpeople.org and contact@freespeechforpeople.org. Another option is to read aloud the grounds for impeachment at an in-person action.
